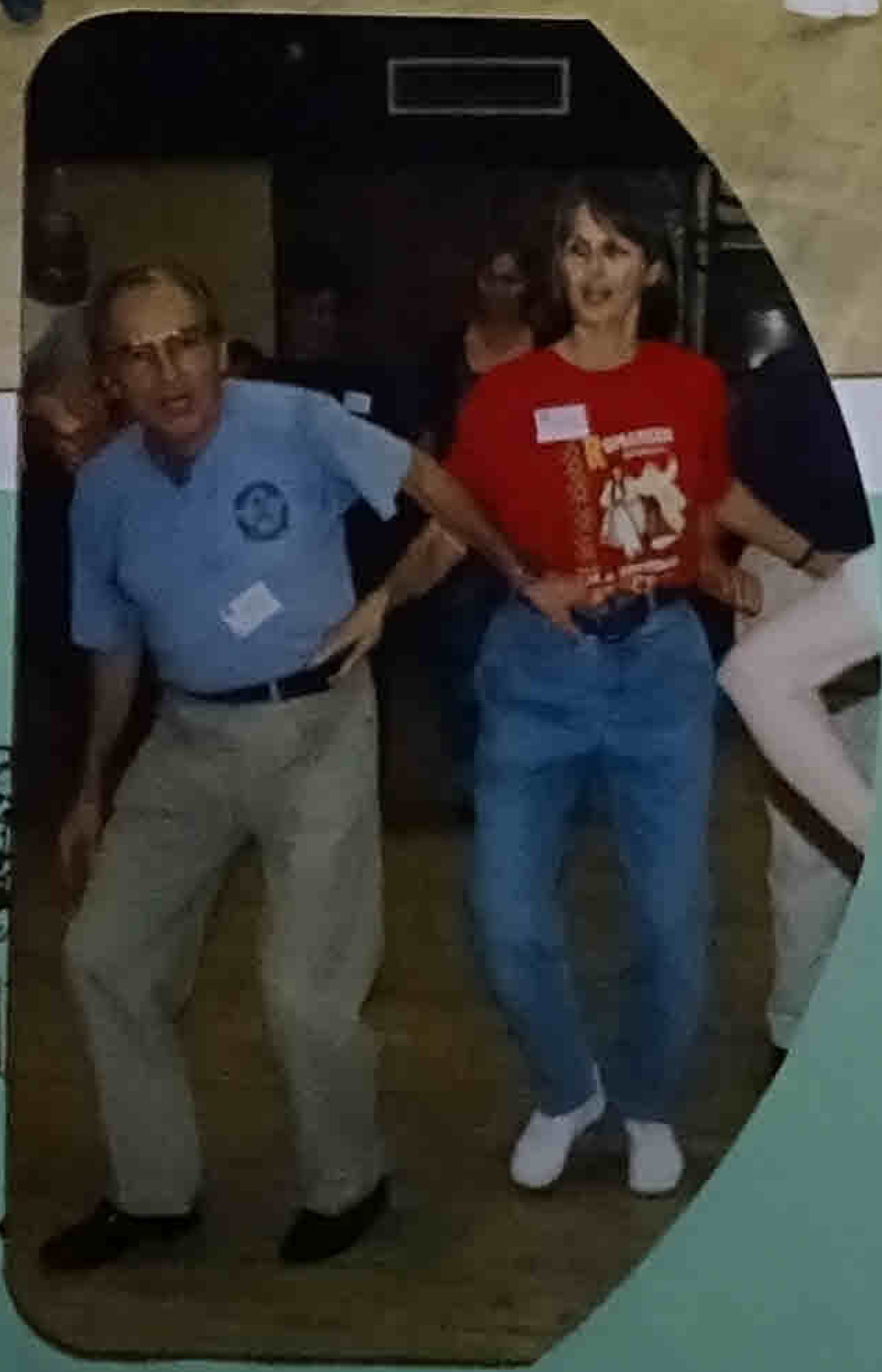


Map showing location: Lincoln Blvd, Jefferson Blvd, Tavera Blvd, Los Angeles (LAX), Hwy, and Ave.

he verbally taught it, was QQS where the Q, Q, and S, came on the '1s' in 12 12 123 (or Hop-Step-Step = 12 12 123). But, if mentally you hop a microsecond *before* the beat, and then do the first step *on* the beat, (or on the *first* 12, as in Step-Hop-Hop = 3 12 12 12 . . .) I think you'll find it much easier, much less tiring, and a lot more fun. At this tempo the difference in the two is more mental, tactual, and proprioceptive, than it is visual; Watching you probably can't tell the difference, except the latter looks easier and more relaxed. And you can also compromise, doing something somewhere between the two.

Step lift facing center, Step on one foot, lift the other foot in front of the supporting foot. (Step Lift = 12 12 123).

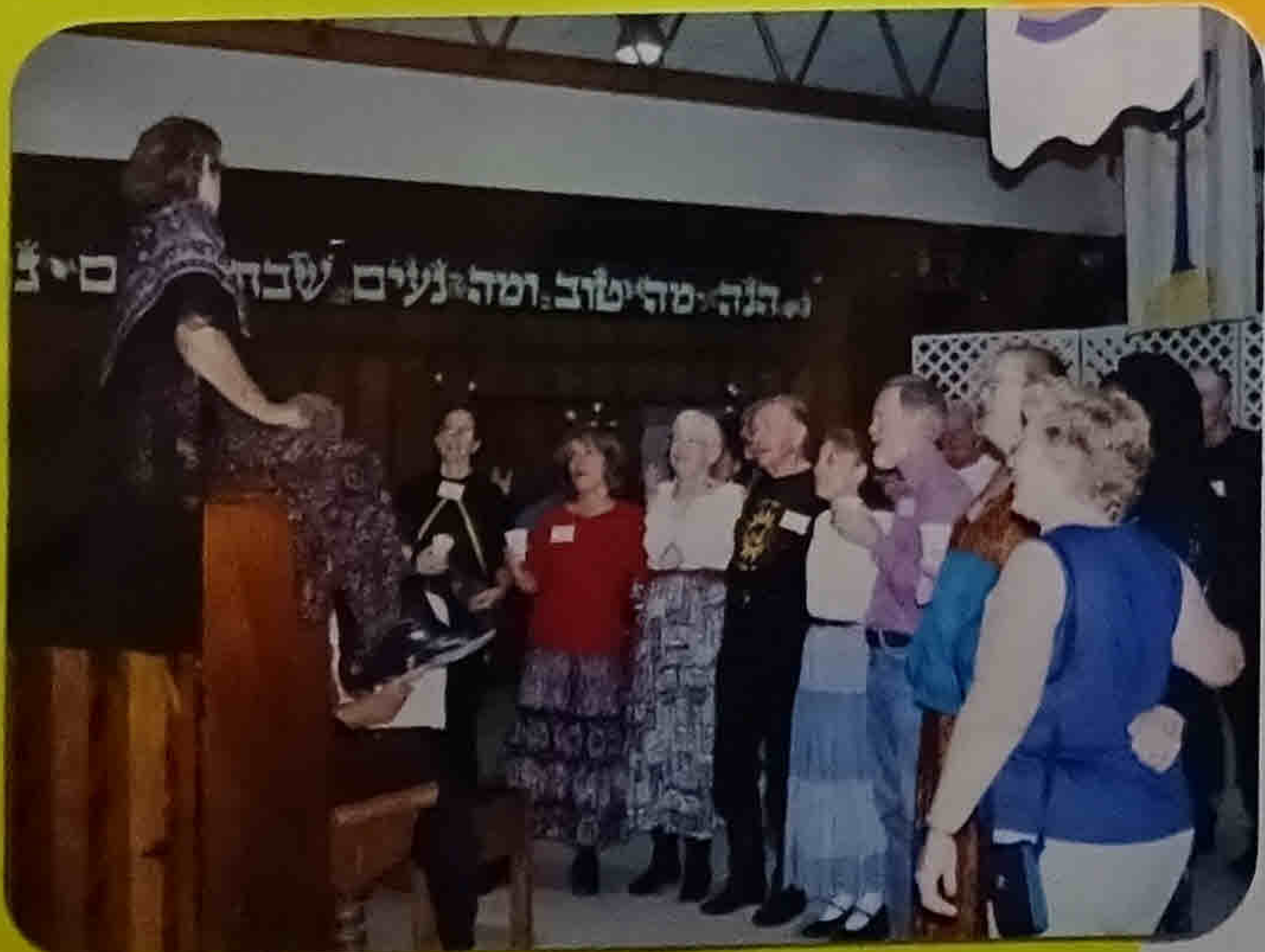
