Welcome to the new Scene

The committee to plan the future of Scene consisted of: Gerri and Bob Alexander, Beverly and Irwin Barr, Gerda Ben-Zeev, Rich Duree, Ruth Levin, Forrest Gilmore, Sandy Helperin, Stephanie Johnson, Leo Markman, and Jill and Jay Michtom. Additional input was given by Steve Davis, Steve Himmel and Marvin Smith and Teri Hoffman.

The committee parceled out the jobs that Teri and Marvin have been doing alone for 14 years. We reported to Council in January and received unanimous acceptance. Jill and Jay will be coordinators, and we were very fortunate to get Pat Peterson to do layout.

The new Scene is smaller in size, but will contain all the essentials. We would like more input from Federation and readers. A note was sent to all clubs inviting them to send monthly activities, guest teachers, temporary changes of address, etc. to Jill for 'On the Scene' (see inside cover for addresses). We'd like ethnic recipes, restaurant reviews (especially in the area of an upcoming festival), Letters to the Editors, "How I got started in folk dancing", whatever. The above to go to Pat Peterson. We'd like more short articles and fewer long ones.

Calendar items still go to Jay; changes in club address, days or time, to Steve Himmel. Irwin Barr has the new ad structure and rates (cheaper!, especially for Federation clubs).

Hope you like the new format. We'll be sending out an opinion survey in May. Meantime, comments are solicited.

FOLK DANCE SCENE HISTORY

We are trying to reconstruct the history of Scene. Here is a first cut, supplied by Dorothy Daw. Corrections and additions are welcomed.

1963-1967? It was started by Bill Rosenthal in the mid 60's (since this issue is Volume 35, it seems reasonable to assume that the first issue was March 1964). At that time it was 2-3 pages, and primarily a calendar of events.

1967-1969? When Bill left, it became a Federation newsletter, under Dick Oakes who added articles from readers and club flyers.

1969-1980? Paul Pritchard took over and ran it for ten(?) years. The emphasis was still on the calendar, but also clubs special events, and flyers added a lot to the content. Paul also included articles highlighting people who contributed much to folk dancing. Pictures were supplied by John Filcich, and covers were done by Walt Metcalf.

1980-1985? Laurie and Mitch Allen took over, and upgraded the appearance and format of Scene. It became more of a magazine rather than a newsletter.

1985-1999 Teri Hoffman and Marvin Smith were the editors for these 14 years, the longest stretch of any of the editors. They added lots of photographs, did considerable research, and wrote many detailed articles on folk dance related subjects.

1999-? Now we have a committee doing the job, and are hoping for lots of input from the clubs and individual members.

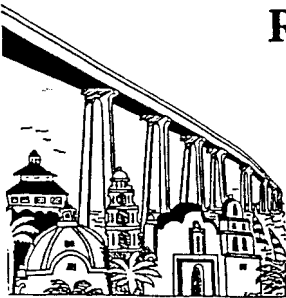

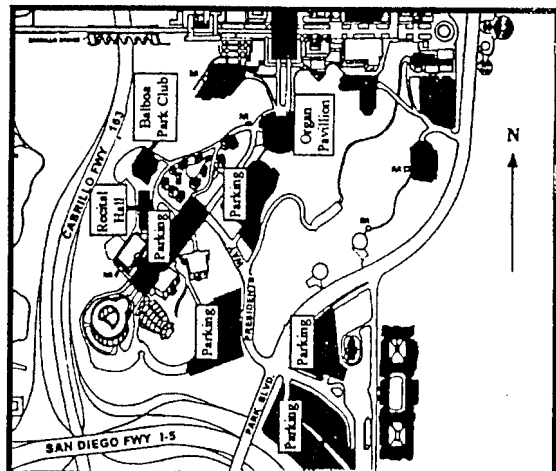

Stuffed Cabbage

Laurette Carlson

- 8 large green cabbage leaves
- 1 ½ cups cooked rice
- 1 medium onion chopped
- 1 tsp salt
- ¼ tsp pepper
- 1 lb ground beef
- 1 egg slightly beaten

- 1 can of tomatoes (1 lb) chopped
- 2 medium onions chopped
- 2 beef boullion cubes
- 1 tsp salt
- ¼ cup lemon juice
- 3 tablespoons brown sugar

Cover cabbage leaves with boiling water. Let stand at least 10 minutes. Mix cooked rice, one onion, 1 tsp salt, pepper, ground beef and egg.

Drain-cabbage leaves. Spoon mound of rice mixture into center, tuck in sides of leaves and fold ends over securely. Place in large saucepan or dutch oven seam side down.

Add tomato, 2 onions, boullion cubes, salt. Cover and simmer for 1 hour.

Remove cover, add lemon juice and brown sugar, cook uncovered ½ hou or more. Reheats well! Serves four.

Note: I always make a lot more than 8 leaves. I use a whole cabbabe and increase the other quantities accordingly, but the basic recipe above is what I base everything on.

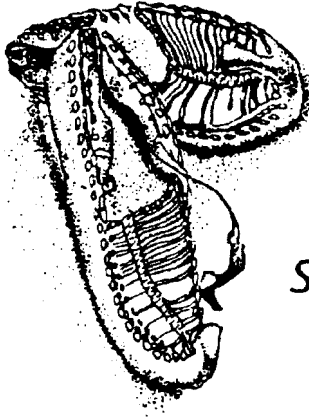

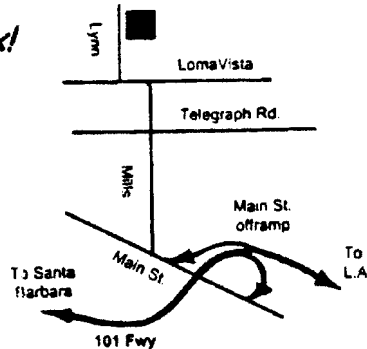
