AUSTRALIAN LADIES

Record: "The Edinburgh Castle Reel" TAC Sound TAC 004

A 32 bar reel for three couples done in a four couple set so each couple does the dance twice.

Bars

- 1 8 First couple cross, right hand, cast down behind partner's line for two places, and dance four hands across with third couple. Second and third couples join hands on the side and move up on bars 3 and 4.
- 9 16 First couple dance, right hands, up the middle, cross above second couple and cast into second place on their own side. Third couple move down on bars 15 and 16.
- 17 20 First couple cross, right hands and cast around their first corner position, WHILE all corners set and change places, right hands across the dance to finish facing up and down the dance.
- 21 24 First couple change places, right hand, up and down the dance and cast round their second corner position, WHILE corners set and change placed, right hands, up and down the dance to finish facing across the dance.
- 25 32 First couple continue clover leaf pattern of cross and cast WHILE corners repeat setting and changing places. All finish on own side, first couple in second place.
