Pattern

Intro: 16 measures

1. Basic

- Facing ctr, small step on R to R (1) step on L in front of R (2) I
- Step on R to R (1) step on L behind R (2)
- Repeat pattern of meas 1
- 3 4 Small step on R in place (1) light hop on R raising L bent knee (2)
- 5 Repeat pattern of meas 4 with opp ftwrk
- 6 Repeat pattern of meas. 4
- 7-12 Repeat pattern of meas 1-6, reversing direction and ftwrk.

2. Heel clicks

- 1-3 Repeat pattern of meas 1-3, part 1
- Drop weight onto R, extending L leg out to L(1) close L to R in a sort of "clicking" motion (2)
- 5 Reverse pattern of meas 4
- Repeat pattern of meas 4 6
- 7-12 Repeat pattern of meas 1-6, part 2, reversing direction and ftwrk

3. Heel clicks and "chugs"

- 1-6 Repeat pattern of meas 1-6, Part 2
- Facing diag L, small leap onto L, "flicking" R ft in back sharply (1) small 7 sharp jump onto both feet with slight knee bend (2)
- 8-9 Repeat pattern of meas 7, two more times
- 10-12 Repeat pattern of meas 10-12, part 2

Note: Leader calls changes of figures at will
