 HASAPIKO (Greece) (HÄH-SÄH-PEE-KÖH)  
 (FAST)

- SOURCE:** This Greek dance was done by the butcher's guild in the capitol of Byzantium, Constantinople. It was done by men at that time. Now the women have joined in this dance.  
 HASAPIKOS COMES FROM THE WORD HASAPIS WHICH MEANS BUTCHER
- MUSIC:** Folkraft L.P. 8 2/4 Rhythm
- FORMATION:** In a line, arms around each other's shoulders. Leader at R end, may put hand on hip or out to side about shoulder height. All face center, moving to R.

| 1            | 1          | Step R to R.                        |
|              | 2          | Step L in front of R.               |
| 2            | 3          | Step R, swing L ft across in front. |
| 3            | 4          | Step L, swing R ft across in front. |
- VARIATIONS:** Step close to R.  
 Turn to R.  
 Skip backwards
