

HOLSTEINER DREITOUR THRE TOUR FROM HOLSTEIN (three musical parts)

RECORD: EP 58615 or Sp 23052 ENGLISH DESCRIPTION BY GRETEL DUNSING

Holstein is a German province just south of Denmark.

FORMATION: Four couples in a square, # 1 facing music, # 2

Measures opposite # 1, # 3 right of # 1 and # 4 opp. # 3.

- 1-16 Circle Cw and CCW, all hands joined. W a l k i n g steps throughout the dance.
- 17-20 Cpl. 1 and 2 exchange places, 1 diving under the arch formed by 2, in opposite place make and individual turn, twd. partner, facing center again with W on partner's left.
- 21-24 R turn to places in the same manner, this time 2 diving under the arch formed by cpl. 1.
- 25-32 Cpl. 3 and 4 as cpl. 1 and 2, 3 going under the arch x fist.
- 33-40 GRAND RIGHT AND LEFT turn partner by the right hand once around in opposite place (39-40) and
- 41-48 continue Grand right and left home, once around by right hand in home position (47-48)

SECOND TOUR

1-16 TURN R HANDS WITH PARTNER, TURN IN PLACE (1-8) and l. hd. (9-16)

1-16 3rd tour WOMEN JOIN HANDS AND CIRCLE CW AND CCW

1-16 4th tour Men join right hands FOR A MILL (1-8) LEFT HAND MILL (9-16)

17-48 THE C H O R U S. IS DONE THE SAME WAY IN ALL TOURS

1-16 ENDING CIRCLE ALL JOIN HANDS, CIRCLE CW AND CCW.
