

Hora Ploii (Hora Rain)
(ploy-ee)

This is an old Hora from the village Mitreni, County Ilfov (not far from the Bulgarian border). It is performed by men and women in a closed circle on all dance occasions. The melody is specific to the dance. The dance phrases and the musical phrases are not the same length, a phenomenon common to dances from the southern part of Romania. The musical phrase is eight measures of 2/4 while each part of the dance takes up only six measures. The dance and music are concordant after four repetitions of each part. The dance has a rustic, earthy quality. The steps are flat footed with the arm movements providing the dynamic.

Position - "W" 

Formation - Closed circle

Music - 2/4

Rhythm Part I: INTRO FIGURES

Facing forward

 Step L sideways L, swing R foot forward.

 Repeat to R, begin R.

 Moving forw. diag. R, step L, close R, step L, swing R foot forward.

 Facing forw. moving directly backw. and step R, step L, step R, swing L foot forw.

Repeat all 3 more times (4x in all)

Part II: THE DANCE

 Step L in place, stamp R heel, stamp R foot
(arms are raised to "W" position). 

 Stamping step R in place, stamp L heel in place, light stamp L in place (arms remain in "W" position).

 Moving diag. forw. R ~~HANDS GO UP TO HIGH POS~~

 Stamping step L, heel lift L (almost a hop but do not leave the ground), step R.

 (Arms swing down and back and stay there until last measure)

 Stamping step L, swing R foot forw.

 Facing forw. moving backw. step R, step L.

 Step R in place, stamp L heel, stamp L lightly (arms go up to "W" or starting position).

 Repeat Part II ~~3 more times (4x in all)~~ until end of music
