



Formation:	Trio facing trio around the room. For purposes of description, it is assumed that ea threesome is made up of two women with a man between them.	ich
Steps:	Skip Change of Step throughout.	
<u>Bars</u>	Pattern	
Chord	INTRODUCTION Bows and curtseys.	
1-4	M dance out to their R between the lines and cast around the W diagonally to their	R. Fig 1.
5-8	Dance three hands across giving R hands:	
	1st M with 2nd M's R-hand W and his own L-hand W.	
	2nd M with 1st M's R-hand W and his own L-hand W.	
9-12	M with L hands joined, facing twd their own lines, Set and turn halfway. Fig 2.	



13-16 M dance R hands across with the other two W. All finish back in orig places. *Fig 3*.

17-20 Joining hands in lines of three, advance 2 Skip Change of Step, retire 1 Skip Change of Step, and clap 3 times. *Fig 4*.



All pass opp person by R shldr. Join hands with own line and Set to oncoming threesome.All dance six hands round and back to place.

Repeat dance with a new threesome.
