



| 5-8 | Dance three hands across giving R hands: | |
| | 1st M with 2nd M's R-hand W and his own L-hand W. | |
| | 2nd M with 1st M's R-hand W and his own L-hand W. | |
| 9-12 | M with L hands joined, facing twd their own lines, Set and turn halfway. Fig 2. | |

13-16 M dance R hands across with the other two W. All finish back in orig places. *Fig 3*.

17-20 Joining hands in lines of three, advance 2 Skip Change of Step, retire 1 Skip Change of Step, and clap 3 times. *Fig 4*.



All pass opp person by R shldr. Join hands with own line and Set to oncoming threesome.All dance six hands round and back to place.

Repeat dance with a new threesome.
