

OH, HOW LOVELY IS THE EVENING (ROUND) ○

Formation: Three circles, facing in each circle, holding hands

How to Perform: All sing song as round and each circle inside, middle, and outside, in turn dance Viennese waltz rhythm, quick series of three steps.

Counts 1-6: "Oh how lovely is the evening, is the evening,"
(Circle left and face center of hall on last count.)

Counts 7-12: "When the bells are sweetly ringing, sweetly ringing,"
(Circle right and face center of hall on last count.)

Counts 13-18: "Ding, dong, ding, dong, ding, dong"
(Swing arms back and forth toward center of circle and backward.)

Each circle dance part that circle just before it finishes.

After completing dance third time, inside circle keep repeating last line of "Ding, dongs." Middle circle do same after finishing sequence for third time. As outer circle finishes sequence for third time and on last note all three circles swing arms forward and up and hold them there for last note.
