Formation: Mixed lines, hands joined down or belt hold. Dance movement is always to L.

	PART I.
1	Step on L (ct 1); close R to L, taking wt (ct 2).
2	Step on L (ct 1); close R to L (no wt)(ct 2).
2 3 4	Step on R (ct 1); close L to R, taking wt (ct 2).
4	Step on R (ct 1); close L to R (no wt)(ct 2).
	Done as many times as leader desires and music is slow.
	PART II. Use very small (sitno) steps.
1	Step on L (ct 1); close R (ct &); step on L (ct 2); close R (ct &).
2	Step on L (ct 1); close R (ct &); step on L (ct 2); hold (ct &).
2 3	Hop on L (ct 1); step on R behind L (reel step)(ct &); hop on R (ct 2); step on L
	behind R (reel step)(ct &).
4	Step on R (ct 1); step on L (ct &); step on R in place (ct 2).
	When music slows, back to Part I.
	When tempo increases, do Part II.
