(POM-MOO-LEH-TEOOL)

"Pomuletul" means 'The Little Tree', and the dance comes from the Village Balta in Muntenia, Romania. Presented by Sunni Bloland at the 1976 Mendocino Folklore Camp.

Music: 2/4; either no intro. or wait 8 meas.  
Record: Roemeense Volksdansen Nevo #12153, Side 1, Band 3  
Formation: Closed circle of M and W, "W" posn. (Arms jiggle in "W" posn throughout.)

- Meas. ~~upbeat In place, a hop L (at 8)~~
- 1 Step R (1), hop R(&), cross L in front (2), hop L (&)
  - 2 Step back R(1), hop R(&), step L to L(2), hop L(&)
  - 3 Cross R in front (1), hop R(&), step in place L(2), hop L(&)
  - 4 Step R ~~to~~ <sup>place</sup> R(1), hop R(&), ~~cross L in front~~ <sup>step in place</sup> (2), hop L(&)
  - 5 Step R in place (1), hop R(&), step L in place (2);  
stamp R (~~to~~ <sup>fwd</sup>)
  - 6 Moving fwd step R(1), stamp L(&), step L(2), stamp R(&) <sup>LEAVING TO L</sup> <sup>FWD</sup> <sup>DIAG</sup>
  - 7 Stamp R (1), stamp R (<sup>fwd</sup> 2)
  - 8 Reeling bkws hop L (<sup>fwd</sup> 1), step R (<sup>fwd</sup> 1), hop R (<sup>fwd</sup> 1), step L (2) <sup>BEHIND R</sup> <sup>BEHIND L</sup> <sup>BEHIND R</sup> <sup>L KICK</sup>
- hop L (at 8).
