(Circle Left !)

I NEVER FELT MORE LIKE SINGING THE BLUES
CAUSE I NEVER THOUGHT THAT I'D EVER LOSE
LEFT ALLEMANDE THAT OLD CORNER, YOU'RE GONNA WEAVE THAT OLD RING
ALL THE WAY AROUND - - - WHY
DO-SA-DO YOUR GIRL, MEN STAR TO THE LEFT IN THE MIDDLE - GO
ONE TIME AROUND, DO A DO-SA-DO
PROMENADE HER HOME - - -
YOU'VE GOT ME SINGING THE BLUES - - - - (HEY NOW!)

FIGURE - Twice for heads, Twice for sides

FOUR LADIES PROMENADE GO INSIDE OF THE RING, COME BACK
AND SWING THE PARTNER ROUND, HEADS (SIDES) SQUARE THRU FOUR HANDS AROUND
YOU GO WALKING AROUND, - SPLIT TWO
AND MAKE A LINE, GO EIGHT TO THE MIDDLE AND BACK - WHY
STAR THRU, THE FRONTIER WHIRL, THE CORNER YOU SWING
SWING THAT GIRL, PROMENADE THE RING
AROUND NOW - - - YOU'VE
GOT ME SINGING THE BLUES - - - (HEY NOW!)
