Israeli Circle Dance

- PRONOUNCED: Tsa-Dik Ka-Ta-Mar
TRANSLATION: Righteousness Shall Flourish
RECORD: Back from Israel, Hadarin LP-3
DIRECTIONS: Instruction booklet enclosed with record,
Back from Israel, Hadarin LP-3.
FORMATION: Circle. Hands joined down in simple hold.

Meas Counts Pattern

PART I:

- 1-4 Walk R, L, R, L.
5-8 Sway on R, L, R, L with feet wide apart.
9-16 Repeat Counts 1-8, Part I.

PART II:

- 1-4 Facing center: step on R to the right side,
cross with L in front of R, step with R to
right side, step with L behind R.
5-8 CW turn while moving to the right side:
Step on R to right side, then cross-turn w/ L,
step on R and cross with L over R.
9-12 Step back on R, step with L to left side,
cross with R over the L, step back on L.
13-16 Sway on R, L, R, L with feet wide apart,
while facing center.
17-32 Repeat Counts 1-16, Part II.
