

**AFED DUDA**  
**(Macedonian Rom Line Dance)**  
**(sometimes called KRSTACKA)**

**SOURCE:** This is a dance done in Shutka, a suburb of Skopje which houses one of the largest communities of Rom (Gypsies) in the world. The dance is very similar to other crossing dances in the region such as Pembe, Postupano, and many others.

**FORMATION:** Hands held in W position

**MUSIC:** New Millennium - "Mchandija" or Zlatne Uste In the Center of the Village - "Lel Devla"

**RHYTHM:** 9/8 q q q s counted as 1 2 3 4
