i-viii INTRODUCTION

- 1 1 Step forward on R heel.
& Close L ft. to R ft, taking weight.
2 Step forward on R ft.
& Hold.
- 2 Repeat Meas. 1 with opposite footwork.
- 3 Repeat Meas. 1.
- 4 1 Leap slightly backward onto L ft.
2 Leap slightly backward onto R ft.
- 5 1 Step on L ft. in place.
& Step to L across in front of L ft. on R ft.
2 Step on L ft. in place.
& Step to R on R ft.
- 6 1 Step to R across in front of R ft. on L ft.
2 Hop on L ft.
- 7 1 Leap diagonally forward to R onto R ft, facing slightly to L.
2 Step Diagonally backward to L on L ft.
& Close R ft to L ft, taking weight.
- 8 1 Step to L on L ft.
& Close R ft to L ft, taking weight.
2 Step to L on L ft.
- 9 1 Leap onto R ft in place.
& Stamp L ft in place.
2 Leap onto L ft in place.
& Stamp R ft in place.
- 10 1 Step to R on R ft.
& Step to R across in front of R ft on L ft.
ah Step on R ft in place.
2 Leap onto L ft in place.
& Stamp R ft in place.
- 11 1 Step on R ft in place.
& Step to R across in front of R ft on L ft.
2 Step on R ft in place.
& Hold.
- 12 1 Click R ft with L ft, taking weight on L ft.
2 Click L ft with R ft, keeping weight on L ft.
