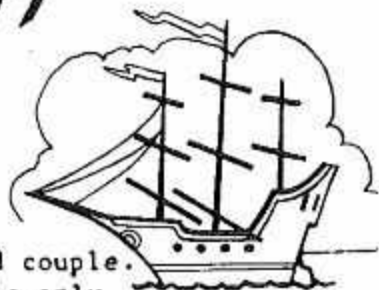

RECORD: Canterbury Country Dance Band F-72-FW 3 Stereo

FORMATION: Contra lines, men on one side, ladies on the other, couples numbered 1, 2, 1, 2, etc.

Measures

- 1-8 First man leads partner with inside hand down through second couple. Separate and come up the outside back to place. First couple only turn partner with two hands once around.
- 9-16 Second couple leads up through first, separates and returns to place. Second couple turn partner with two hands once around.
- 17-20 First man turns second lady with two hands once around to place.
- 21-24 Second man turns first lady with two hands once around to place.
- 25-32 All set twice (R,L,R,L), then do three changes of a circular hey, as follows. Begin by giving R hand to partner and changing places. Next, 2 men change places, giving Left hands; 2 ladies do the same at the same time. Finally, change places with partner again by R hand, ending up on your own side of the set. No. 1 and no. 2 couples will not have changed places.
N. B. This figure may also be done without taking hands; simply pass R, L, then R shoulders.
