	PART II. PASTOURELLE (changing place turning W)
B 1-2 3-4	Ptrs change places, M turning W CCW under the joined R hands, using 2 bourrée steps. In ptr's place, dance 2 bourrée steps.
5-8	Repeat meas 1-4.
