Beg.

(Circle dance for women)

Translation: Circle dance from region of the Galga River.Record: Folkraft LP-28 (side B band 5)—zither (2:19).Starting Position: Front Chain Position. Right foot free.

FIGURE I (Music A^{1**})

- 1 ♩ A slow STEP-CLOSE sideward right (counts 1-2 3-4).
 2 ♩ STEP-CLOSE sideward right (counts 1-2).
 3 ♩ One CIFRA STEP (right)(counts 1-and-2),
 ♩ Step sideward left on left foot, keeping right foot in place without weight (count 3), pause (count 4).
 4-12 REPEAT measures 1-3 thrice (4 times in all).
 13-18 A small step on right foot diagonally backward right (count 1),
 A small step on left foot diagonally forward right (count 2); and . . .
repeat nine more times (10 times in all), circle moving left.

FIGURE II (Music B¹)

Music 4/4

- 1 ♩ Facing slightly right and moving right, two small running steps (right, left) forward (counts 1-2),
 ♩ Turning to face center, a slight jump on both feet slightly apart (count 3), pause, freeing left foot (count 4); and . . .
 2-3 REPEAT measure 1 twice (3 times in all) alternating footwork and lateral direction.
 4-5 Circle left with four OPEN RIDA STEPS (left).
 6 REPEAT measure 1 reversing footwork and lateral direction.

Music 2/4, 4/4

- 7-8 ♩ Facing slightly right and moving right, four small running steps forward starting with right foot (counts 1-4),
 ♩ Turning to face center, a slight jump on both feet slightly apart (count 5), pause, freeing left foot (count 6); and . . .
 9-10 REPEAT measures 7-8 reversing footwork and lateral direction.

Music 4/4

- 11-13 REPEAT measures 4-6 reversing footwork and lateral direction, circling right.

FIGURE III (Music B²)

- 1-13 As II above, reversing footwork and lateral direction (circle starts moving left).
 REPEAT above I-II-III sequence (to Music A²B^{3,4}) . . .

ENDING (Music B⁵ measures 7-13)

- 7-13 As II above, . . . OR
 7-12 Circle right with ten OPEN RIDA STEPS (right).
 13 As II measure 1 above.

**Music A measures are in a series of 4/4+2/4+4/4.
