

GAMLE Nr. 12 (Danish)

A 2-couple set dance from Langeland, Denmark

MUSIC: Hedebo Spillermændene (tape cassette)
FORMATION: 2 couples opposite each other
STEPS Hurretrin (buzz step) walking step. Chasse

PATTERN

Figure 1

- 1-4 a) Circle CW. 8 hurretrin, hands joined shoulder high
Circle CCW 8 hurretrin
- 5-7 b) With opposite, dance 6 walking steps CW. Begin inside feet
looking each other in the eye. On count 8, step away
from circle
- 8 and bow to partner.
- 9-11 c) Chain; 3 chasse steps, begin Right hand to partner,
Left to opposite, and holding with Left hand extend
Right to partner; so Ladies are standing with "pretty
side out"
- 12 1, 2, 3 in place - L R L, on meas. 12
- 9-11 Continue chain, Right to partner, Left to opposite, Right to partner
and 3 steps to get in starting position facing opposite couple
(no stamps)

NOTE There are 8 figures which the caller can choose from (on the cassette
the music is played $5\frac{1}{2}$ times.) Of these figures only the "a" part
changes. The "b" and "c" parts remain the same. The dance ends with
figure 1 "a" and no "b" or "c"

- Figure 2 a) Couples may dance 8 hurretrin CW with Right hands joined,
8 hurretrin CCW with Left hands joined.
- Figure 3 a) Couples may dance 8 hurretrin CW with both hands joined
8 hurretrin CCW
- Figure 4 a) Couples join Right hand in R & L in L and dance 8 hurretrin CW
8 CCW
- Figure 5 a) Ladies two hands joined
- Figure 6 a) Men two hands joined
- Figure 7 a) Ladies "crossed arm" Right in Right; Left in Left
- Figure 8 a) Men "crossed arm" Right in Right: Left in Left

Dance end with big circle 8 hurretrin CW. 8 hurretrin CCW, as it began but
without the chorus figures "b" and "c". The music is played $5\frac{1}{2}$ times on the
cassette.
