

(English Folk Dance)

## MUSIC

## PART I

- A1 1-4 All join hands and dance 8 slide steps clockwise (sl. s).  
 5-6 All release hands and turn single.
- A2 1-4 All join hands and dance 8 slide steps CC.  
 5-6 All release hands and turn single.
- B1 1-6 The men join hands, dance in a circle 12 slide steps Clockwise to places.
- B2 1-6 The women do the same.
- C1 1-2 Men move forward a double toward the center, swinging arms up and clapping hands above heads on the third step, i. e., on the first beat of the second bar.  
 3-4 Women the same; while the men fall back a double to places.  
 5-6 Men move forward as before; while women fall back a double to places.  
 7-8 Men fall back a double to places, turning single as they do so.
- C2 1-8 As in C1, the women starting the movement instead of the men.

## PART II

- A1 1-4 Partners siding.  
 5-6 All turn single.
- A2 1-6 All Repeat.
- B1 1-6 The women take hands and dance round in a ring twelve slides clockwise back to places.
- B2 1-6 The men the same.
- C1 1-8 As in First Part, the women starting the clapping movement.
- C2 1-8 As in First Part, the men starting the clapping movement.

## PART III

- A1 1-4 Partners arm with the right.  
 5-6 All turn single.
- A2 1-4 Partners arm with the left.  
 5-6 All turn single.
- B1, B2, C1 and C2 As in FIRST PART.

In practice it will be found advisable to limit the number of dancers to six couples.
