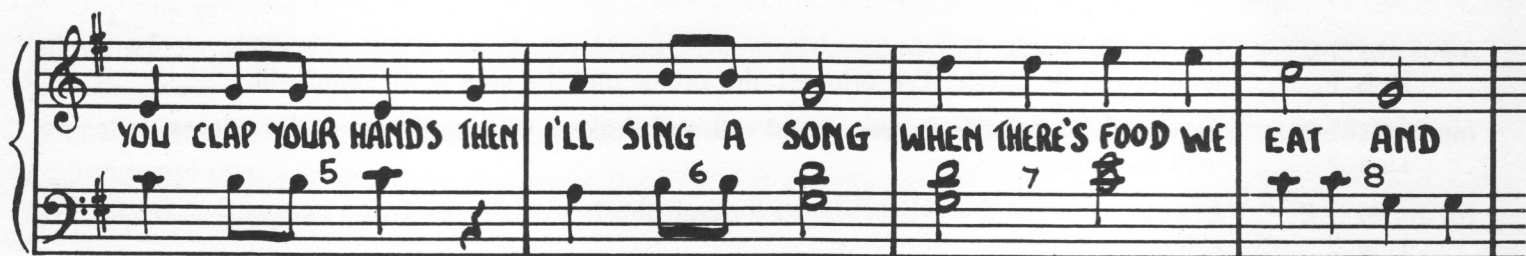
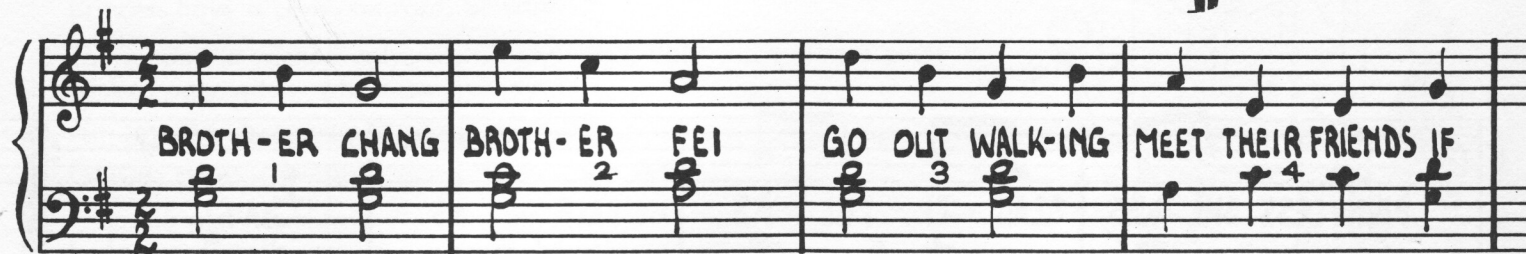
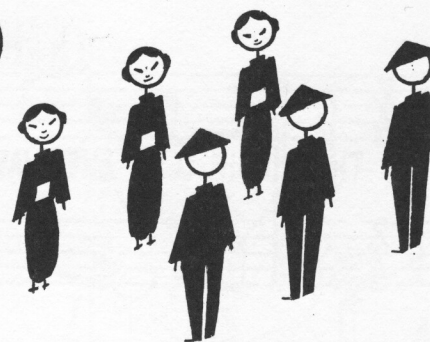

Opening Formation Dancers stand in two lines facing each other. Boys on one side, girls on the other.

| Measures 1-2
Line 1 | Everybody sings. Partners skip four steps toward each other. |
| Measures 3-4
Line 2 | Dancers bow or curtsy to partners and clap hands. |
| Measures 5-12
Lines 3-5 | Partners join hands in skating position and face counterclockwise. Dancers skip sixteen steps in a circle finishing in their original positions. |
| Measure 13
Line 6 | Dancers drop hands and all laugh heartily. |
