Israeli Couple Dance

PRONOUNCED: Gca-se Lee

TRANSLATION: Shearing the Sheep

CHOREOGRAPHER: Johathan Karmon

RECORD: Tikva - 148, Souvenir Israeli Folk Dances

MUSIC: 4/4

FORMATION: Couples: woman on Man's right. Man's right arm around ptrn's. waist, joined left hands in front. Face CCW. Both start with same foot.

Meas Counts Pattern

PART I:

- 1 Leap R fwd.
- 2-3 Step fwd L, R.
- 4-5 Step bkwd, L, R.
- 6 Face ctr. Jump on both feet.
- 7 Hop on L in place.
- 8-11 Yeminite-Hop on R.
- 12 Face CW. Leap L fwd.
- 13 Step R fwd.
- 14 Step L bkwd and turn to face CCW.
- 15-28 Repeat Counts 1-14, Part I.

PART II:

- 1-8 Join inside hands, girl in front of man. Do 8 bounce steps fwd. Begin R.
- 9-16 Release hands. Woman makes $\frac{1}{2}$ turn to R. Right shoulders next to each other. Do 8 bounce steps, once around moving CW. On last two steps woman makes one full turn to her R side. Man claps on the first four counts, twice to each count. On the last four counts, Man claps only once to each count.
- 17-32 Repeat Counts 1-16, Part II.
