

GRAND SQUARE.

(LONG VERSION)

1. HONOR YOUR PARTNER. Bow/courtesy to your partner.
2. ALLEMANDE LEFT. Men turn to their corners (on left), take a left ~~elbow~~ ^{forearm} hold and walk around each other.
3. GRAND RIGHT AND LEFT YOU GO. Take partners by right hand and proceed around the square, alternating between left and right hands with each successive person.
4. PROMENADE YOUR PARTNER. When partners meet, ^{take R hands & counter-} men turn the lady (clockwise) under their raised right hands and into a "western promenade" position (varsouvienne), and proceed around the square counter-clockwise back to the original position. *OR USE "KARATE" PROMENADE POSITION.*
5. BOW TO YOUR PARTNER. Men bow to their partners as they release the promenade hold.
6. ALL FOUR GENTLEMEN STAR. Men form a right-hand star (hold the wrist of the person ahead) and proceed clockwise halfway around the square.
7. TURN YOUR OPPOSITE LEFT AND STAR. Men turn the opposite lady with a left ~~elbow~~ ^{forearm} hold and reform their right-hand star to proceed back to their partners.
8. TURN YOUR OWN - ALL FOUR LADIES CHAIN. Men should ignore the call to "turn your own", (there isn't time). Men should simply reach out to take their partner's right hand and ~~assist her~~ ^{lead it} into the center for the lady's chain.

Ladies form a ^{low} right-hand star ^{and} turn clockwise halfway around the square to the opposite man, who gives them a courtesy turn. (Ladies extend their left hand and place their right hand on their right waist. Men take ladies' left hand in their left, place their right hands on the ladies' right hand at their right waist, and turn them around to face the center again).

9. CHAIN 'EM BACK AGAIN. Repeat the "Ladies Chain" of step 8 to return ladies to original position. Men provide a courtesy turn. *All finish in position per the original square.*

10. GRAND SQUARE. Do the entire Grand Square dance, starting and ending with a chorus of Grand Square, as called.

11. Repeat steps 2 through 9 (The calls are repeated).

12. GRAND SQUARE. Do the ~~entire~~ ^{chorus} Grand Square dance again, as in step 10.
