

GREEN SLEEVES AND YELLOW LACE

English Country Dance for 3 couples.

Record: E.F.D.S.S. PR-EP 318 45 rpm. Country Dance Society of Am.  
55 Christopher St. N.Y., N.Y. 10014

- Music Meas. First man and first woman set and cast off into 2nd  
A1 1-4 place, second couple moving up.  
5-8 Second couple do the same.  
A2 1-8 As in A1.  
B1 1-8 First man passing down the middle does the figure 8  
thru 3rd couple, passing CCW round 3rd woman and CW  
around 3rd man; while 1st woman, following 1st man,  
does the figure 8 thru second couple, passing CW  
round 2nd man and CCW round 2nd woman.  
B2 1-8 First man (passing his partner by the right) does the  
figure 8 thru second couple, passing CCW round 2nd  
woman and CW round 2nd man; while first woman does  
the figure 8 thru 3rd couple, passing CW round 3rd  
man and CCW round 3rd woman.  
A3 1-6 First man hands-three with 3rd couple once and a half  
round; while 1st woman and 2nd couple do the same.  
7-8 First man (passing his partner by the right and facing  
up) joins 3 hands with 2nd couple; while the 1st  
woman (facing down) joins hands-three with 3rd couple.  
A4 1-6 First man hands-three once and a half round with 2nd  
couple, and 1st woman hands-three once and a half  
with 3rd couple.  
7-8 First man and first woman (passing by the right)  
move into second place (proper).  
B3 1-8 First man does the hey with 3rd couple, passing 3rd  
woman by the left; while 1st woman does the hey with  
2nd couple, passing 2nd man by the left.  
B4 1-8 First man (passing his partner by the right) does  
the hey with 2nd couple, passing 2nd woman by the rt;  
while first woman does the hey with 3rd couple, pass-  
ing the 3rd man by the right. First couple cast off  
into 3rd place, 3rd couple moving up. Now the 2nd  
couple, and then the 3rd couple repeat the dance.

(If this dance should be done as a longways triple minor, first  
couple would end in second place and that would be the progression)
