

## HISTOVEIVEE

(Israel)

Record: Folkraft 1106B

Formation: Double circle all facing CCW. The M on the outside of the circle with both of his hands raised shoulder high, W on the inside of the circle, slightly behind M and holding M raised hands.

Pattern: Two types of steps may be executed (choose your own). Either a slow "step-together-step-and" to 1 meas, or 2 such steps to 1 meas. The latter seems to be preferred. Six such "two-steps" to 3 meas. On the last meas everyone calls out "Histoveivee," (hiss-tow-vey-vee), and at the same time ptrs release R hands and with the L hands the M turns the W to the M in front of him whose hands this new W joins and the dance starts from the beg. It is a simple dance but a good mixer.

"Histoveivee" means "turn around."
