

THE MAID PEEPED OUT OF THE WINDOW or THE FRIAR IN THE WELL (English)

(Longways dance for as many even numbered couples as will)

First Part:

- A 1-4 All lead up a double and fall back a double to places.
5-8 That again.
- B1 1-4 First man followed by the rest of the men casts off to the bottom of the set while the women do the same, (sk s).
5-8 Partners set and turn single.
- B2 1-4 As in B1, 1-4, casting up to places, (sk s).
5-8 Partners set and turn single

Second Part:

- A 1-8 Partners side and again.
- B1 1-2 All face up. The men go 4 slip steps to their right while the women go 4 slip steps to their left (both finishing improper) the men passing in front of their partners.
3-4 All move up a double.
5-8 Partners set and turn single.
- B2 1-2 All face down. The men go 4 slips to their right, the women 4 slips to their left the women passing in front of their partners.
3-4 All move down a double.
5-8 Partners set and turn single.

Third Part:

- A 1-4 Partners arm right.
5-8 Partners arm left.
- B1 1-4: All couples half-poussette, odd couples change places with even couples by moving towards the right wall (women's wall) first, (r s).
5-8 Set and turn single.
- B2 1-4 As in B1, continue the poussette, odd couples move towards the left wall initially.
5-8 Set and turn single. (Peter Eccles, Lighted Lantern Camp, 1978)
