MUSIC: Record: Folk Dancer MH 1120. MAH-REE-O-WAH-RAH

FORMATION: Couple Dance. Boy holds girl above the waist; she rests her hands on the top of his shoulders.

THE DANCE

Girl's and Boy's steps start with the Right foot.

PART I



ft. 1 & Girl and Boy take one step sideways with the Right foot, bringing the Left foot close to the Right without weight on it.

ft. 2 & Same as above starting with the Left foot.

DURING MEAS 1 & 2
M SLIGHTLY "TWISTS" W
ON EACH STEP

ft. 3 & 4 & Both step with the Right foot to the Right in the line of the circle. Bring Left foot close to the Right and put weight on it. Step to the Right with the Right foot. Bring the Left foot close without putting weight on it.

Your Left foot is now free. Start the entire sequence again starting with the Left foot; all together four times. ~~Slide into turning position, boy's Right foot beside girl's Right foot, pivoting right turns Right and right Left.~~

7 BUZZ STEPS ON R, STEP R (CT 1)
PIVOT ON R TO FACE OTHER SIDE (CT 2)
8 BUZZ STEPS ON L
