MENIM BALAM

Menim Balam, which translates as "my baby" is an Azerbaijani women's dance. The music is a lullaby in which the mother and the chield converse back and forth. Ercument learned this dance in Turkey in 1987 from the visiting Azerbaijani state artists from the Soviet Union. The dance was first introduced to the U.S. in New York, in March 1988.
