

MEXICAN WALTZ MIXER

Record: "Atotonilco" - Musart 1154

Dance Formation: Partners in skater's or promenade position facing LOD, couple behind couple in circle, Lady on Man's Right.

THE DANCE:

1. Starting outside foot, gal's R, gent's L, walk 6 steps and turn on 7 & 8 to face RLOD. The turn is made by keeping skater's hold and turning toward each other.
2. Walk 8 steps RLOD.
3. Drop partner's L hand and join with neighbor's in single large circle, gals facing in, gents facing out.
4. Everyone balance forward and back and keep the R-hand hold and walk half-way around so that the men are facing in and the girls are facing out. Join hands again in the large circle.
5. Balance forward and back, drop R-hand hold and turn by L hand to promenade position to start dance all over again.
