<u>Ne Bashqe</u> is a popular song in Kosovo. For presentation outside of Yugoslavia, three dances which are common in Kosovo have been joined together to form a simple line dance. <u>Part 1</u> is a basic <u>Lesnoto</u> pattern. <u>Part 2</u> is a step pattern often performed to the song "O Sazana" in southwest Kosovo. <u>Part 3</u> is a common <u>Hora</u> pattern performed by women of Prizren. In Kosovo, only one of these motifs would be performed throughout the song. The musical arrangement here is part of a choreography from the Shota Ensemble.
