## Pattern

- INTRODUCTION Long tupan (drum) introduction, followed by 2 chords on gaida (bagpipe). Dance begins with following drum beats. During the dance the leader may serpentine the line.
- Moving fwd on the R diag, facing slightly R of ctr, step R ft fwd.
  Continuing in the same direction, step fwd L ft.
- 2 1 Continue on R diag, step fwd R ft.
  - & Step fwd L ft.
    - 2 Step fwd R ft, turning slightly to face ctr.
- 3 1 Backing out from the ctr: step bkwd L ft.
  - & Step bkwd R ft.
    - 2 Step bkwd L ft.
