1-2 Introduction

I. Traveling Polka

M and W begin L, do 7 polka steps fwd in LOD. 1-7

Stamp R(ct 1), L(ct 2), and turn 1 CW in place to face RLOD, without 8 releasing hands. Joined L hds will now be raised, R hds low.

Stamp R twice(cts 1, 2), M sing "Hop, Siup"(Hope, Shoop) in time with 1 the stamps.

Put wt on R ft and pivot ½ CCW in place to face LOD. R arms are raised. 2 W sing Tra-la-la(cts 1, &, $2\underline{\&}$).

Rpt meas 1-2 with opp ftwk and dir. 3-4

Rpt meas 1-2. 5-6

Stamp L twice, then M turns W with his L hd 3/4 CW into closed dance 7-8 pos. W pivots on L into pos.

III. Turning Polka Do 8 polka steps turning CW in LOD, 2 turn per meas. M begins L, WR. 1-8 End with M back to ctr.

IV. Slides M stamp L, WR twice(cts 1, 2), M sing "Hop, Siup". Joined hds point 1

toward floor. 2

Do one polka swd in LOD(cts 1&2), M sing "Tra-la-la". 2

Rpt meas 1-2, with opp ftwk and dir. Joined hds point up. 3-4

Rpt meas 1-4. 5-8

Turning Polka

Rpt Fig III, meas 1-8. 1-8

VI. Pivot Turn

M stamp L, WR twice(cts 1, 2), M sing "Hop, Siup". 1

Do one pivot turn CW in LOD, M steps LR, W steps RL. Keep knees bent 2

and stay level. W sing "Tra-la-la". Rpt meas 1-2 3 more times. W take a "catch" step R on ct 24 of meas 8 3-8 so L ft will be free to start dance over.

Dance repeats twice more.
