Record: Aqua Viking V860A

Formation: Cpls holding inside hands (facing LOD).

Measures Pattern

- I.
1 - 2 1 chasse (two-step) and 2 walking steps fwd (CCW); during the last step M turns to R, W to L, and they join other hands.
3 - 4 1 chasse and 2 walking steps CW.
5 - 8 Polka, turning CW, progressing CCW.

Repeat all.

A California discovered variant uses 4 pivot steps instead of the 3rd and 4th polka steps.
