Translation: Rheinlander-Polka Tune title: "Den Gamle i G". Pronunciation: ryne-lenn-dehr polka. Record: Aqua VIKING 860 a.

Formation: Any nr of cpls in circle, LOD CCW.
Positions: Single hand hold (at shldr level), Formal closed posn.

Footwork: Opp thruout; two-step, walking step, polka. Character: Light and smooth.

1-2	A. Fwd and back:
1-2	With inside hands joined, facing fwd, bgng on outside ft, 1 two-ster
	followed by 2 walking steps, in LOD. On last walking step, M turns
	half about to own R, and W to own L, and other hand is joined with ptnr.
3-4	Bgng on other ft (which is now outside), I two-step followed by 2'
	walking steps, in RLOD.
	B. Polka turn:*
5-8	In formal closed posn, 4 polka steps turning CW and progressing fwd
	in LOD.
	Sequence repeated as many times as music allows.
