Carry us through the desert on the humps of the Camel Caravan. The part of the dance going into the center, to the music li, li, li, etc. signifies the tinkling of the many bells around the camel's neck. It is the music of the desert.

Formation: Open circle, facing center, hands held up bent at elbow (W position)

Part 2, Facing Center:	
Step R fwd (1), brush L around back, slight lift on R (2), step L back, with slight lift on R (3), hold (4)	
Repeat 1-4	
Step R fwd (9), step L fwd (10), step R back (11)	
Make 3-step full turn to L, releasing hands (R,L,R)	
Close R to L (15) and hold (16)	
Repeat 1-16	
Part 3:	
Going to center, step R,L,R, lift L slightly off floor	
Step L,R,L, lift R slightly off floor	
Repeat 1-8 moving backwards away from center	
Step R back, hands down	
Step L back	
Step R fwd, lifting hands, brushing L fwd off floor	
Touch L heel on floor	
Touch L heel on floor	
Repeat 17-24, starting with L	
Yemenite step R and Yemenite step L	

Note: After repeating dance twice, add two additional Yemenite step-hops, and lifting joined hands up, shift to R, shift to L, Close R to L, bringing hands down, body bent forward.
