

SHALOM AL YISRAEL

Dance: Yonatan Gabai
 Formation: Solo, face front towards the music.

PART 1

- 1: Standing in place, twist upper body to right.
- 2: Snap fingers to right, hands held close together.
- 3: Standing in place, twist upper body to left.
- 4: Snap fingers to left, hands held close together.
- 5-8: Repeat counts 1-4.
- 9: Step R to right.
- 10: Lightly stamp L next to R without weight, while snapping fingers to right.
- 11: Step L to left.
- 12: Lightly stamp R next to L without taking weight, while snapping fingers to left.
- 13-16: Repeat counts 9-12.
- 17-32: Repeat counts 1-16.

PART 2

- 1: Wide step with R to right.
- 2: Hold.
- 3: Cross L behind R.
- 4: Step R to right.
- 5: Cross L over R.
- 6: Step bwd on R in place.
- 7: Step L to left.
- 8: Cross R over L, clapping hands in front.
- 9-16: Reverse counts 1-8 stepping L to left.
- 17-32: Repeat counts 1-16.

PART 3

- 1: Step R to right.
- 2: Kick L fwd.
- 3: Step L to left.
- 4: Stamp R next to L without weight.
- 5-12: Repeat counts 1-4 two more times.
- 13: Step R to right.
- 14: Kick L fwd.
- 15: Step L to left.
- 16: Cross R over L.
- 17-32: Reverse counts 1-16 stepping L to left.

PART 4

- 1-2: Step-together-step starting with R, moving fwd diagonally to right.
- 3-4: Step-together-step starting with L, moving fwd diagonally to left.
- 5-8: Repeat counts 1-4. Turn 1/4 turn to R on the last step-together-step, counts 7-8.
- 9-32: Repeat counts 1-8 three more times, ending up facing fwd, towards the music, to begin the dance.
