MUSIC: X106-A Express. 4/4 meter.

FORMATION: Open, mixed circle with little finger hold at shoulder height.

Meas PATTERN

- Facing ctr, touch L across R (cts 1,2); touch L to L (cts 3,4).
- 2 Repeat meas 1.
- 3 Step L over R (cts 1-2); cross R over L (cts 3-4).
- Cross L over R (ct 1); step R to R (ct 2); step L behind R (ct 3); step R to R (ct 4).

Facing slightly and moving LOD, step on R as arms go down

Note: Dance begins where musical phrase begins.
