

SPINNRADL (Spinning Wheel)

There are many versions of this dance form. This one is taught in Eastern U.S. It is from the Muehlviertel.

Record: Tanz EP 58129

Formation: Couples in Varsovienn position on the line of the circle.

1-4 with four step-close-steps fwd. in LOD, beginning on outside feet. Lady moving to inside of circle on meas 1 and 2 then moving to outside of circle (man's right side) on meas 3 and 4.

5-8 with four step-close-steps (change steps) as above but with lady staying on man's right side, couples move LOD.

9-12 With hands still joined lady moves once around man making a full CW turn as she passes in front of and behind man ending outside of circle, facing each other with joined hands crossed (RT on top).

13-20 Joined hands are raised, couple turns under joined hands alternately, she turns CW on the outside of the circle, he CCW on the inside of the circle. Couple moves fwd slightly in LOD while turning. She has $3\frac{1}{2}$ turns, he 3 turns so that with meas. 16 they are facing each other. Turns must run smoothly one into the other without a stop.

21-24 Couples move LOD with joined hands in front with four step-close-steps.
