Record

Formation: 6 to 8 couples, 2 lines facing about 6 ft. apart, holding hands shoulder height

I Searching

Fwd 6 and back 6; Repeat. Starting R foot

II Herding

1st couple down center, turn into each other, run back half way and turn with R elbow

III Shearing

Reel: Man 1 now runs to foot girl and turns her with L arm, while woman turns 2nd man (head). Turn each other with R arm; and next woman and man until all have been turned

IV Washing wool

1st Couple join M's R and W's L hand and run to foot of set; turn R; raising joined hands as both lines turn to left and kneel. 1st cpl run up over man's line to head, and down woman's line and take place at bottom of set as all stand.

V Threading Loom

All run fwd 6 steps; partners join inside hand; even cpls arch facing down, odd cpls face up. Over and under until couples return to original position (wait at each end for 6 counts)

VI Shuttle

Even couples backward toward foot (6 steps); odd couples fwd toward head (6 steps) --continue the shuttle until at original position. (wait at each end for 6 counts)

VII Ravel

M's R hand and W's L hand joined--M's left hand cross underneath taking next girl's R hand.

1st man lead line up center, turn right, goes back to foot position, and backs under his R arm, W backs under left arm; other couples follow.

VIII Double Ravel

1st man again leads line up under arches and turns R and winds the line around number 2 woman; as they close in raise the joined hands forming an arch thru which she leads out followed by the others. Woman #2 leads the line CW in a circle and joins hands with the 1st man.

IX Dividing Colors

Partners face: R and L Grand with elbow swing. Meet partner, join both hands and turn cw until the end of phrase; finish in a single circle with inside hands joined and raised.
